

The William and Dorothy Judah Scholarship Fund

Applications must be received by 5:00 p.m., Friday, April 27, 2012

Eligibility & Selection Criteria:

1. Thurston County high school graduates attending a Washington public college or university. Those attending private colleges are not eligible for this award.
2. Preference will be given to those pursuing a career in teaching.
3. Selection will be based on merit. Merit is determined by using the following factors:
 - ◆ Demonstrated Academic Ability: Must have demonstrated a capacity to succeed in school.
 - ◆ Career Goals: How the scholarship contributes to your future career goals. Preference will be given to those entering the teaching profession.
 - ◆ Extracurricular Activities/Community Service: Volunteer projects and active participation in school activities.
 - ◆ Life Experience: Voluntary or paid work experience.
 - ◆ Applicant Appraisal: Two letters of recommendation of which one must be from a teacher/advisor and one from someone who can comment on your overall character, achievement and promise.
 - ◆ Other. Special circumstances such as family, financial or personal problems which may make you more worthy of consideration.

Awards generally will not generally exceed \$1,000.

Application Instructions:

When completing the application form, please keep the following points in mind:

1. Name: Use your proper name in the same order as listed on the form.
2. Address: All correspondence will go to the mailing address provided unless you specify a temporary address (at school for example) with valid starting and end dates. Without dates, all mail will go to your mailing address.
3. Telephone Numbers: Please provide an alternate telephone number.
4. Two or four-year institution: Applicants must have already been accepted for admission to a two or four-year institution.
5. Email: Make certain your address is legible as we will use this to contact you.

Personal Statement – Write a short statement indicating your reasons for wanting to attend a two- or four-year institution, your course of study and your career goals. Include other information that will show the Committee you are a worthy grant recipient (e.g. outstanding attributes, talents, service to school or community, commitment to pursuing educational goals, motivation and family circumstances).

Transcript of Grades – *Include a copy of your most recent grade transcript.*

Two Letters of Recommendation – One letter must be from a teacher/advisor and one from someone who can comment on your overall character, achievement and promise. These letters must have been written within the last year and must contain your full name. Please *do not* send more than two letters of recommendation.

Form with fields for High School, Expected Graduation Date, SAT Score, Four-year institution you are planning to attend (Choice 1 and Choice 2), Major, Degree, and Expected Graduation Date.
