

**DAN R. MONTGOMERY SCHOLARSHIP**  
**For Students Pursuing Professional Law Enforcement Careers**  
**Applications must be received by 5:00 p.m., Friday, April 27, 2012**

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Applicants must have already been accepted for admission to a two or four-year institution and plan to pursue a professional law enforcement career. Those planning to attend a college or university in Washington State will be given preference

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Applicants must **write** a short statement indicating your reasons for wanting to attend a two or four-year institution, your course of study and your law enforcement career goals. Include your extracurricular activities (with an emphasis on community service, law enforcement or helper roles) and other information that will show the Committee you are a worthy grant recipient (e.g. outstanding attributes, talents, service to school or community, commitment to pursuing educational goals, motivation and family circumstances).
2. Include a copy of your most recent transcript or ask the last school you attended to send a copy to The Community Foundation of South Puget Sound, Attn: Dan R. Montgomery Scholarship Fund, 212 Union Ave. SE, Ste. 102, Olympia, WA 98501.
- 3) **Include Two Letters of Recommendation:** One letter must be from a teacher/advisor and one from someone who can comment on your overall character, achievement and promise. These letters must have been written within the last year and must contain your full name. Please **do not** send more than two letters of recommendation.
- 4) **A copy of your Student Aid Report (SAR):** A completed SAR is used to determine your financial need. This document is returned to you when you complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA is available from many high school counselors or college financial aid offices. Please send a copy of Part 1 of the SAR, pages 1 and 2, and include this with your application.

Please keep the following points in mind:

1. Name: Use your proper name in the same order as listed on the form.
2. Address: All correspondence will go to your permanent address unless you specify a temporary address (at school for example) with valid starting and end dates. Without dates, all mail will go to your permanent address.
3. Telephone Numbers: Please provide an alternate telephone number whenever possible.
4. Two or four-year institution: Applicants must have already been accepted for admission to a two- or four-year institution.
5. Email: Please make certain your address is clear as we will use this to contact you.

## Scholarship Background



Dan R. Montgomery served the residents of Thurston County as their elected Sheriff from 1979 through 1986. Sheriff Montgomery passed away in January 2005. In addition to serving as Thurston County Sheriff, he was a Traffic Officer with the California Highway Patrol and Deputy Sheriff in Yuba County, California in the 1960's and 1970's.

The Montgomery family established the Dan R. Montgomery scholarship fund in 2003 to encourage young women and men to pursue higher education. The specific focus of the fund is for students who wish to pursue the honorable profession of law enforcement officer. The Dan R. Montgomery scholarship fund is limited to High School seniors residing in Thurston County. Those who plan to attend a two-year, or four-year public college or university in the State of Washington will be given preference for the award.
