**NBA Great Lenny Wilkens
to Share Reflections on 40 Years in Basketball**

Northwest sports legend Lenny Wilkens will conduct a small, informal presentation in Olympia to benefit The Community Foundation of South Puget Sound and The Lenny Wilkens Foundation. The limited seating event will be held Wednesday, April 22nd at 10 a.m. at Indian Summer Golf and Country Club in Olympia.

Wilkins is one of only two people inducted into the National Basketball Association (NBA) Hall of Fame as both a player and a coach. Wilken's talk will focus on his winning strategies from 40 years with the NBA. Wilkens coached the Seattle SuperSonics to their first and only NBA championship (1979). He was inducted into the Washington Sports Hall of Fame in January, 2009. Following his career in sports, he established The Lenny Wilkens Foundation which has raised \$2M over the past decade to support organizations that provide basic healthcare and education with dignity to culturally diverse communities in the Northwest. His presentation is a collaboration between The Community Foundation of South Puget Sound and The Wilkens Foundation.
